It is hereby agreed that as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 there will be General Committee meetings every 2 months (wherever possible) to include:


1. Managing Trustees

Meetings will discuss improvements to and the general management of the Village Hall. The Trustees will seek advice and opinions from the various representatives to assist in the decision making process.

Should there be any outstanding issues supported by a 75% majority of those present, (from 2,3 and 4 above), then representatives can call for an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Village Hall Charity following the procedure laid down in the Constitution dated 19<sup>th</sup> October 2010, to have these issues discussed in more depth with the Trustees.

Nothing in this document in any way supersedes or overrides the Constitution dated 19<sup>th</sup> October 2010. All decisions relating to the control and management of the Hall remain finally the responsibility of the Trustees as elected at the Annual General Meeting.
