



**Minutes of the Rowney Green Ordinary Meeting  
Held on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2019**

**Planning Issues / Neighbourhood Plan**

Voting on the acceptance of the District Plan was on 10<sup>th</sup> January. The plan has been generated by the community for the community so attendees were encouraged to vote. A letter was also presented which evidenced Historic England's support of the plan.

Current planning applications were discussed including Jasmine Cottage, Newbourne Hill and Bordesley Hall Farm. A proposal to include Rowney Green in the Alvechurch emergency plan was also discussed.
