Planning Issues / Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Plan has been adopted having been approved by a large majority (97% in favour).

We will be requesting that planning applications and the objection process is made more transparent. It was also suggested that it is possible to set up alerts for notifications of planning applications in your area.

The RGA continue to fund CPRE membership for the village and all meetings are attended by a resident.

Road safety

A big thank you to everyone in the village who has cut back the hedges. This has improved visibility and should improve road safety for everyone.

There continues to be concern about the safety of speeding cyclists in the village. The Chair will contact local cycling associations and an article on the hazards will be written for the Calling Oak and Village magazines.

The health and safety inspection has failed and we are trying to find out why so further action can be taken to address the issues raised if necessary.

Funding for the purchase of a smaller grit bin for the hill on Chapel Lane has been raised for consideration by the RGA.
