**Planning Issues / Neighbourhood Plan**

John Cypher took us through the next stages of the Neighbourhood Plan development and implementation.

There was a proposal to develop a Rowney Green Community Plan to set out what amenities the residents would like to see in the village. This will be considered in future meetings.

**Road safety**

We await feedback from the County Council on information gathered from the data strip monitoring, organised by County Councillor Charlie Hotham. This has been followed up but remains outstanding.

Five local road cycling groups have been contacted to make them aware of the dangers to cyclists and residents of riding at high speed through the village.

Constable Simon Albutt from the Community Police Service has agreed to attend the next meeting to discuss crime issues and address questions on CCTV within the village.

**A.O.B.**

Annette English, our new District Councillor, has agreed to attend the next RGA meeting in September.

The bench by War Memorial is in poor condition and requires attention. It was agreed to contact Bromsgrove District Housing Trust, the landowners, to seek permission for the R.G.A. to replace the bench. The majority of members present at the meeting were in favour of the R.G.A. funding it. If BDHT grant permission we will seek advice from Dean Croxton on the specification for a new bench.
